

NYCHairbattles Hosts Its First Barber Competition

Brooklyn, NY – June 9, 2017- New York City's first-ever warehouse barber competition from NYCHairbattles is set to debut in Brooklyn this August. The event, nicknamed 'No Sleep Till Brooklyn', will allow barbers from all over the United States to compete in categories commonly requested in barbershops.
