

Montoursville's Got Talent Competition Registration Form

Have a special talent, act, or just like to show of your horse? Then you should enter in the first annual Equestrian Talent Competition held at Elysian Fields in Montoursville, PA this coming August 25!

Deadline to enter is July 31, 2018

Competition guidelines and procedures:

1. Your act must be longer than 2 minutes but no more than 6 minutes long.
2. There are no restrictions on what can be in your act; it just must be equestrian related.
3. Trick roping, bull whips, and other equestrian arts are welcomed!
4. A horse does not have to be used in the act.
5. You may enter more then one act.
6. No age limit.
7. No limit for number of people or horses in each act. Group acts welcome.
8. The top 10 acts sent in will be selected to participate live in the competition.
9. Selected acts should arrive on August 24, 2018 by 3 p.m. to participate in the full rehearsal with Ashley Pletcher. The order of all acts will already be selected and Ashley will be there to help anyone with pointers and/or anything else they may need before the competition.
10. The actual competition will be held on August 25, 2018 starting at 6 p.m. Tickets will be sold for the event as this is a fundraiser to help raise money for 3 different causes.
11. There is no entry fee but ticket sales will benefit charity. The charities that will benefit include: Appalachian Horse Help & Rescue, Linden, PA <http://www.horsehelp911.com>; PSPCA Center at Danville, Danville, PA <https://www.pspca.org/danville>; Injured rodeo bull rider Brandon Presnell.
12. After the competition is over, each audience member will have a voting ballot and will choose who they feel won the competition. Ballots will be tallied and prizes will be given to 1st through 3rd place.
13. Stalls available on site if you would like to stay the night or have use of stall during the days of competition and rehearsal. Cost for stall rental is \$35 per day and can be paid upon arrival. To reserve your stall please indicate number of stalls needed on registration form.
