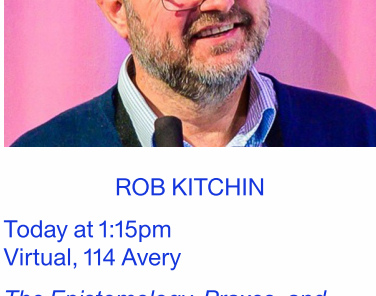

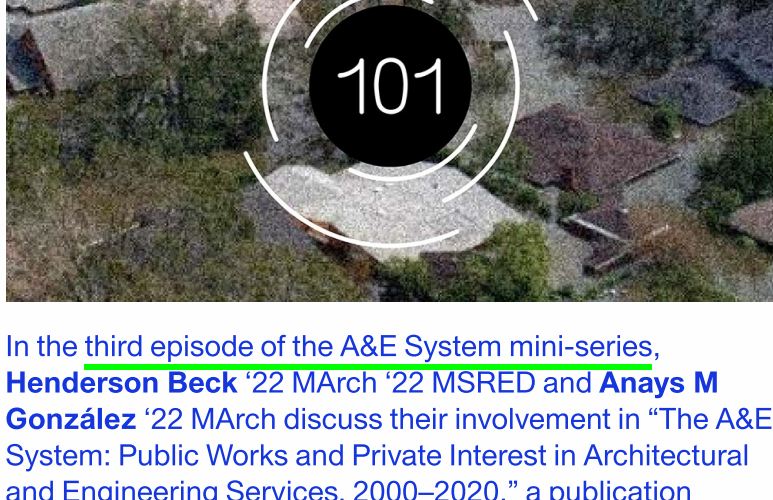

A&E SYSTEM: PODCAST MINI-SERIES

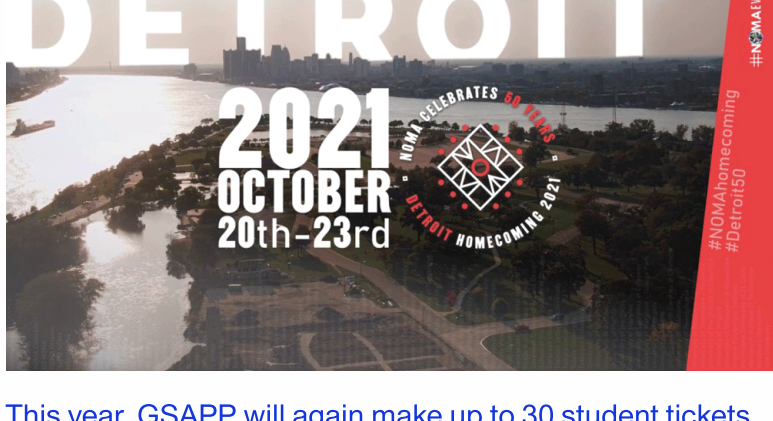
