Professor **Mario Gooden**, Interim Director of the March Program, and **Dominic Leong**, Adjunct Assistant Professor, will provide the response.



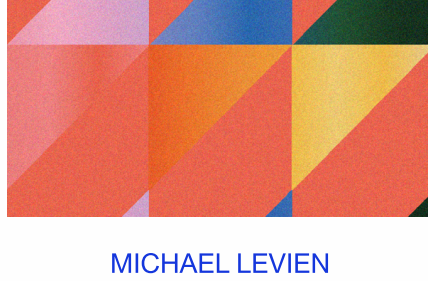

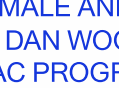
