
ABSTRACTION CHALLENGE: DRAWING SHADOWS

Materials: Paper and a writing tool like marker, colored pencil, or crayon

DRAW

- **1.** Spend some time outside your home and find some shadows cast by objects like trees, flowers, fences, buildings, etc.
 - *Alternative: if you can't go outside, you can use a light source like a lamp or flashlight to create shadows in your own home!
- 2. Once you find your first shadow, take your writing tool and trace it.
- 3. Now find another shadow to draw.
- **4.** Rotate your paper clockwise 90 degrees and start drawing. Make sure you use a different color writing tool for this second tracing, and don't worry about overlapping lines.
- **5.** Once you're done, look at your new abstract artwork!

Bonus: Show your abstract drawing with family or friends and see if they can guess what kinds of shadows you traced!
