With a deeply rooted sense of family and a commitment to excellence, the Department for Persons with Disabilities (DPD) provides residential, vocational, spiritual, and social services to adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families. DPD empowers each person to become active, contributing, and valued members of their community, and to participate fully in life with dignity and respect.

DPD operates 10 group homes, 2 supervised apartments and a vocational day program throughout Northern New Jersey. In addition, we provide support for people with disabilities who live in the community.



We continued to expand our services in 2017. We hired 5 new Support Coordinators who help individuals in Sussex County get the help and attention they need. Our Support Coordination program has

more than doubled throughout the last year. In addition, our Walsh House in Succasunna was purchased and upgrades were made to the home to make it accessible for the people we serve. 6 people with intellectual and developmental disabilities now call this program "home."

Our new group home and overall agency expansion, has been made possible through our fundraisers, most notably, the Wiegand Farm Golf Classic.

With over 8,000 people on a waiting list to get into programs like ours, we still have work to do.
