


Team Up With Your Dog for a Meaningful Volunteer Opportunity Become a Therapy Dog Team!

How would you like to spend time with your dog helping people not only feel better, but actually get better? Canine Therapy Corps trains, assesses, and provides volunteer opportunities for Therapy Dog Teams - like you and your four-legged bestie.

You can have your choice of volunteer assignments ranging from 1 day to 6 weeks (attending once a week.) Participate in as many or as few assignments as you like.

If your dog has passed the Good Canine Citizen test, they are close to being therapy dog ready. We do offer training and certification prep classes, but your dog does not need to take our classes in order to test with us. There is a one-time \$50 assessment fee, but if you don't pass, you can retest at no additional charge.
