**Chris Lowe, PhD** - Professor, California State University Long Beach. *Dr. Lowe works with acoustic and satellite telemetry techniques to study the movement, behavior and physiology of sharks, rays and gamefishes.*



**Barb Block, PhD** - Professor, Stanford's Hopkins Marine Station. *Dr. Block's research focuses on how large pelagic fishes utilize the open ocean environment - centering upon understanding the evolution of heat management strategies in tunas, billfishes, and sharks.*
