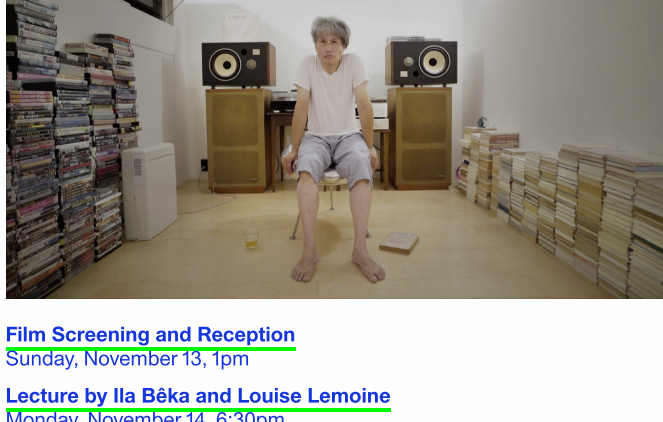

The program features an engaging body of work that spans their distinct 15-year oeuvre and is renowned for disrupting typical representations of contemporary architecture and the urban environment: *Koolhaas HouseLife* (2008), *Barbicania* (2014), *The Infinite Happiness* (2015), *Moriyama-San* (2017), and *Tokyo Ride* (2020).

Following the lecture, the filmmakers will be joined in conversation by **Mark Wasiuta**, Co-Director of the Critical, Curatorial, and Conceptual Practices Program at GSAPP.
