Because of the need of quick construction, the installation have a temporary nature. The bubble requires minimal structure with only the tension created by its inflatable membrane that sits gently on the ground. The geometry of the bubble changes accordingly to the topography underneath. The tension and surface of the bubble create its structure and interior space for groups of people to gather. The transparent surface provides natural light and the experience of being outside but social distanced. Facilities attached to the bubble act like an air intake to also imitate the fresh air in the plaza. Due to the strong circulation axis between Avery Hall and Fayerweather Hall, the arrangement of the inflatable cluster serves as an opportunity to stay.
