MILFORD GRAVES: FUNDAMENTAL FREQUENCY

ARTransmissions serves as a visual aid to reach a deeper understanding of selected artworks exhibited at the museum. Students look carefully at Milford Graves's work *Collage of Healing Herbs and Bodily Systems*. They share thoughts about what they see, what ideas the forms inspire, and identify inspiration for creating artworks of their own.
