WUE Guidelines Conditions for enrollment:

- Effective Spring 2018, the WUE program will no longer be offered for Transfer students
- Applicants must meet the higher academic GPA and subject requirements for nonresident applicants.
- The WUE program is only open to U.S. Citizens and noncitizens legally present in the United States.
- Students pursuing a second bachelor's degree or master's degree are not eligible to participate in WUE.
- WUE students are not eligible for California resident tuition. Students cannot apply time accrued while participating in the WUE program to establish California residency.
- WUE tuition fees rates will be adjusted automatically to full non-resident rate if major is changed to Biology, Business Administration, Kinesiology, Undeclared or Psychology.
- Students may receive WUE tuition for four years or until the completion of the bachelor's degree, whichever comes first (extensions may be granted on a case by case basis).

To maintain WUE status:

Students must maintain full-time enrollment (at least 12 units) each semester and remain in good academic standing.

Comparison of Annual 2017-2018 WUE and Non-Resident tuition rates:

Non-Resident tuition and fees (calculated for 16 units) = \$9,473/Semester*

WUE Tuition and fees (calculated for 16 units) = \$4,957.50/Semester*

Annual WUE Savings = \$9,031*
