- Inspiring stories of Adaptive personalities being included, exhibiting the normality of living with a disability and others showing how they have overcome their adversities.

Combining over more than 30 + accessible reef and beach breaks making the area highly competitive for all Adaptive divisions and performance levels suited to all types of impairments.

Bathers way, a 6km stretch of path paves it's way over distinctly defined beaches, Accessability and exercise friendly footpaths and concrete ramps open up to beautiful vistas and rock pools making the absolute perfect platform for viewing the competition and accessing the surf.

Typically still warm weather in May / June with offshore breezes grooming the swell lines, the city of Newcastle is the ideal location to hold an event with such international stature.
