

**Hello! We are excited to have you participate in celebrating 100 in the May Fete Parade! Here are your details! Please feel free to dress up in a character or style from the last 100 years. Also, we will have a time capsule on-site at the Fair. Feel free to bring anything that will fit into an 8" X 11" envelope for the capsule. Also, drop by the capsule and have your fingerprint added to the outside of the capsule.**

**PARADE DAY:** Saturday, May 4th, 2024 · 10:00 AM, rain or shine!—Since this is a children’s parade, we ask that you keep the number of marching adults to a minimum and encourage parents to watch the parade from anywhere along the route and cheer on all the participants.

**CHECK IN:** 8:30 AM– 9:30 AM. Check-In station will be located at Emerson St. close to University Ave. One adult MUST CHECK-IN with the staff at the check-in table to receive instructions, buttons, and printed stage numbers. ***ALL parade participants are required to wear their buttons to identify that they belong to a group in the parade.*** Printed stage numbers (supplied by City of Palo Alto) will be held by someone in your group so that the parade announcers can announce the correct information of your group.

**PARKING:** Parking will be available at City Hall or anywhere outside of the staging area and parade route.

**RESTROOMS:** Restrooms are located at both parking garages. There will also be portables at Lot O on Emerson St.

**FLOATS:** If you have a float, judges will be located at the judges’ tables in front of the Apple Store and University and Florence Street, make sure they get to see your float or decorations and don’t forget to show them your spirit!

**GIVEAWAYS:** For the safety of our spectators, especially the children, no giveaways are allowed along the parade route.

**PARADE ROUTE:** The May Fete Parade starts at 10:00 AM rain or shine! The parade will start at the corner of Emerson St. and University Ave. The parade will travel down University Ave. and turn right on Waverley St. and **END AT HERITAGE PARK.** Float entries will turn left onto Waverley and park between Homer and Channing.

**END OF PARADE:** Due to the number of participants involved in the parade, a large crowd of people will be waiting at the end of the parade. It is **HIGHLY IMPORTANT** to designate a meeting place prior the parade. **Please do not congregate on the street so that the rest of the parade can cycle through.**

**Please note that we are a Zero Waste community which means absolutely NO BALLOONS allowed.**

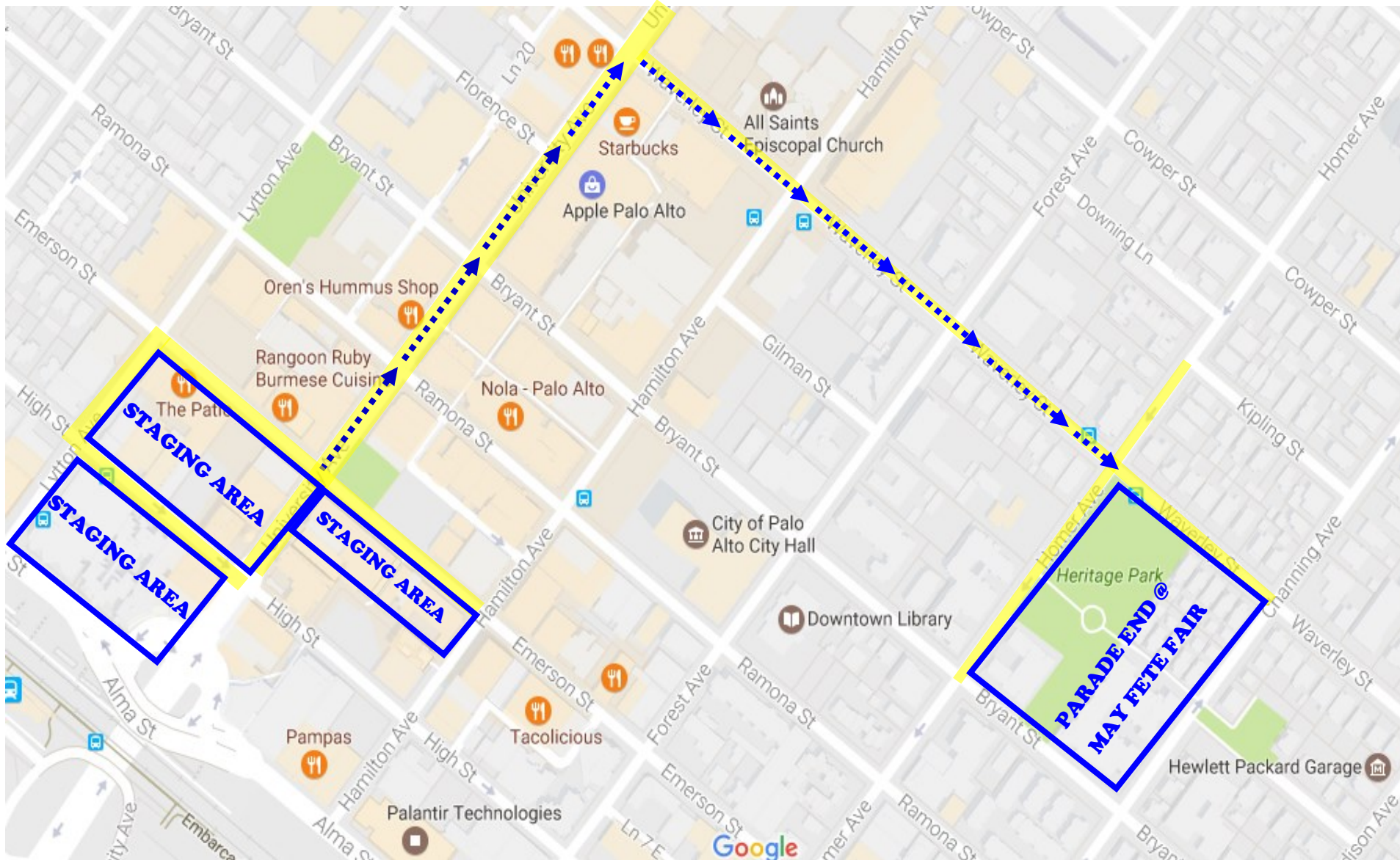
