FIBA — The International Basketball Federation is developing 3x3 as a stand-alone discipline and 3x3 basketball has been included in the Olympic Programme for Tokyo 2020. 3x3 is a simplified version of basketball, played on a half-court with one hoop only and three players a side.

The road map for 3x3 includes an integrated 3x3 Competition Network that connects all FIBA-endorsed 3x3 events and leads to the FIBA 3x3 World Tour (www.3x3worldtour.com). All players participating in FIBA-endorsed 3x3 events are offered an individualized dashboard and are listed in the 3x3 Individual World Ranking, available in play.fiba3x3.com.

Mouhamadou Moustapha Sall, Managing Director of SIREM SPORTS INC is a FIBA 3x3 endorsed organizers. SIREM SPORTS INC informed FIBA 3x3 about their intention to organize a FIBA 3x3 endorsed tour << NYC 3x3 Tour >> during the 2022 summer period and apply through our system to include the event in the Road to World Tour path.

Provided the organizer fills all the obligations, FIBA 3x3 will consider their activity to be included as a qualifier to the Pro Circuit. Any support offered to SIREM SPORTS INC will be very much appreciated by FIBA and will help to further develop 3x3 that is already the top urban team sport in the world.
